


MMS student homework policy:




and thinkers, I expect you to ...


- 
- **Read outside of class** (books, newspapers, magazines, etc.).
 - **Main Goals** - by the end of the year:
 - To read 2 hours outside of class per week (including SRB or at home).
 - To improve reading stamina (how long you can read in one sitting).

Other Items:

- I do not offer extra credit. You will have opportunities to finish incomplete assignments or revise those of poor quality.
- Use work time in class wisely. If needed, finish academic work at home, in SRB, or before or after school.

- You will be placed on the ICU list when you do not turn in academic work, turn in work that lacks quality, or are absent (as a reminder to see me about what you missed).
 - You should see me for assignments BEFORE you are absent for activities or appointments.
 - For extra help, you can see me every day during SRB. I also work Power Hour on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, or we can set up appointments as needed.

Late Work: Your Responsibilities

1. Communicate with me BEFORE the designated due date.
2. Develop a plan with me to complete the work and then follow through. (The plan may involve attending Power Hour.)
3. Use your planner to remind yourself of upcoming deadlines.
4. Establish a routine for completing assignments outside of class so that you can meet deadlines.

Late Work: Mrs. Moege's Responsibilities

1. Put you on the ICU list.
2. Talk to you about the missing work and determine a plan.
3. Remove you from the ICU list when you've completed work the work with quality.
4. Contact your parents if missing work becomes frequent.

Note: I do not deduct points for late work.

3. We will confer regularly your progress. You will also have input about your grades from time to time.
